These are really important years in the life of your pre-teen daughter or son. We hope that the Bible study book this year will allow them to dive deep into the Bible, own their faith and discover what they actually believe.

In 'Trek 2' students will wrestle with the question, "Why am I here?" The desire is for students to know God placed them here to serve and love other people. Jesus is the perfect example of what this life of service looks like. With Trek 2 students will not only discover why God put them here, but how He has given them unique gifts and talents to serve the world around them.

For each lesson in the Trek Bible Study book (see the outline to the left) there are several days of optional devotions. These devotions include some Bible verses to read, some thoughts to reflect on and questions to answer. *Students in grade six, seven and eight have the opportunity to begin or build on the practice of spending time in God's Word every day!!*

To finish your book, these things need to be completed:

1. Memorize and recite the key verse for each lesson
