Notes:

- This year the Trek Bible Study book focuses on "His Love". The students can wrestle with the question "Why am I here?" Our desire is for them to know God placed them here to serve and love other people.
- For each lesson in the Trek Bible Study book there are six days of devotions. These devotions include some Bible verses to read, some thoughts to reflect on and questions to answer. Students in grade six, seven and eight have the opportunity to begin or build on the practice of spending time in God's Word every day!!
- If you'd like to finish your book, then these things need to be completed for each lesson:
- 1. Do the intro activity at the beginning of each lesson
- 2. Memorize and recite the key verse for the lesson
- 3. Complete the corresponding Three-Year New Testament Reading Plan and verses (see pgs 268-269; 1st year in Trek reads Year One etc.)
- 4. Unit Review is not required
- If you're not planning on completing your book, then we'd encourage you to read when you can, and follow along with the lessons that we'll be looking at each Tuesday night. During our large group time at Trek we will be presenting a lesson from the Bible Study book. Here is an outline for the year to help you keep track.
